ENTOMOLOGICAL SOCIETY OF CANADA (“ESC”) POLICY ON AUTHOR RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES

As a publisher, **ESC** understands and recognizes the importance of sharing and distributing research results among the scholarly community. With this in mind, **ESC**'s policy on author rights and privileges is as follows:

Authors retain patent, if any, and moral rights in the article and:

a) upon receipt of the “authorization to publish” signed by all authors the right to:

- Place a draft (*i.e.*, non formatted or edited by the journal) of their accepted article(s) on their web site or on their organization's server, provided that it is NOT amended once considered suitable for publication by **ESC**. We encourage authors to insert hyper-text links from their preprints to **ESC** web site: <http://ESC-SEC.org>;
- Re-use all or part of their article(s) in subsequent publications provided the source is acknowledged;
- Use the text and illustrations for internal purposes, further research and giving public speeches;
- Make copies of their article(s) in electronic or paper format for educational use within the home institution; and
- Reproduce their article(s), in electronic or paper format, for placement in the home institution's reserve collection.

b) upon purchase of PDF reprints authors obtain the additional rights to:

- Post the published article on their web site or their organization's server. The author must include **ESC**'s copyright notice and acknowledge the article's source; and
- Distribute the PDF format article electronically for scholarly purposes.

ESC will retain the right to:

- Negotiate agreements with third parties to further the dissemination of the published information upon condition that the third party identifies therein the source of the work;
- Receive income from the above negotiations, which will be used to further the interest of **The Canadian Entomologist**; and
- Republish articles in alternative formats and editions upon condition that the source of the work is identified.
